

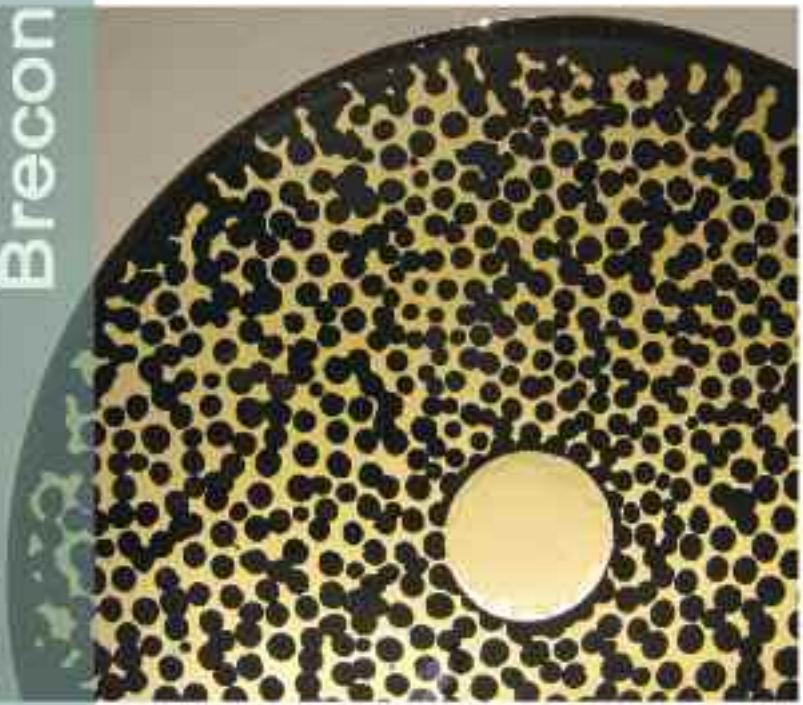

Interested in photography? Enjoy a challenge? Then why not enter Crai Camera Club's Photomarathon in Brecon?

A Photomarathon is a competition with a twist: Over 4 hours you have to take 4 pictures on 4 given topics. Improvisation, fun and creativity are the order of the day in the Photomarathon. This is an entirely digital event - you can take part with a digital camera or mobile phone - just bring a blank memory card and download cable with you.

From 11am on the day of the Photomarathon, each entrant will have their camera and memory card checked and verified and then at 12 noon will be issued with the 4 topics. They have the next four hours to shoot one image per topic, in the same order as the topics are listed. You can delete a photo on the memory card before you continue to the next topic. Titles will offer plenty of room for interpretation and creativity. The club members will then receive the completed entries - via direct download from your memory card. Judging will be completed on the same day and winners notified by email. Winners will have their images enlarged and mounted and can also have the opportunity to see them in an edited version! Images will then be displayed around town during Brecon Arts Festival.

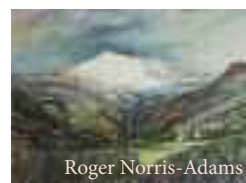

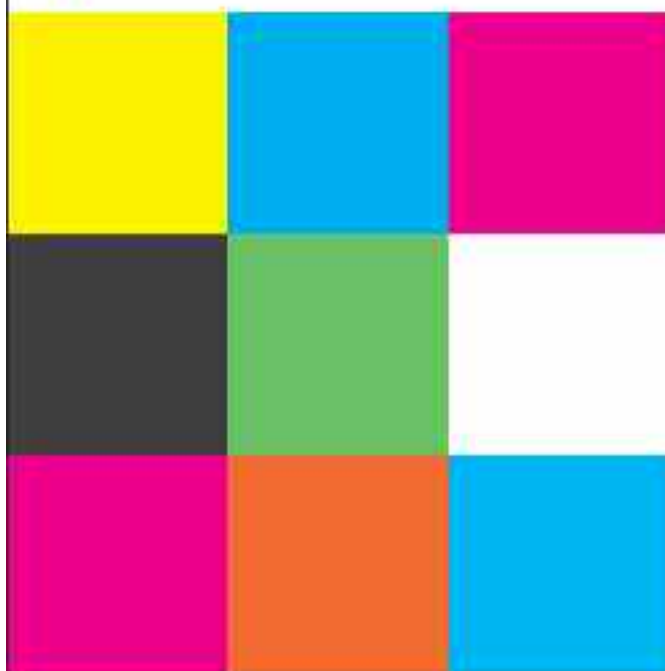
